Applications are invited online only from qualified candidates for selection to the undermentioned post in Kerala Government Service. Applications must be submitted online only through the official website of the Kerala Public Service Commission after “ONE TIME REGISTRATION”.

- 1. Department** : Medical Education
- 2. Name of Post** : Assistant Professor in Genito Urinary Surgery (urology)
- 3. Scale of Pay** : Rs.15600-39100/- with Grade Pay of Rs.7000/-
- 4. Number of vacancies** : 1 (One)

Note 1:- The above vacancies is now in existence. The Ranked list of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancy noted above and that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the period of the currency of the list.

Note 2:- Candidates who are appointed in the post should serve for 4 (Four) years during the first 10 (Ten) of years of their service (including the period of training) anywhere in India or any other foreign country under defence services connected with defence, if required. Differently abled candidates and those who have completed 45 years of age are exempted from the above compulsory military service.

- 5. Method of appointment** : Direct Recruitment
- 6. Age limit** : 21-46, Only candidates born between 02.01.1973 and 01.01.1998 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual relaxation to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Communities.

- 7. Qualifications** :
 1. M.Ch. (Urology)/M.Ch./DNB (Genito Urinary Surgery)/M.Ch. (Genito Urinary surgery).
 2. Three years Teaching experience of such other Teaching experience as prescribed by the Medical Council of India.
 3. Permanent Registration under State Medical Council (Travancore-Cochin Medical Council)

Note:(a)

The Post Graduate study period for Medical subjects will be considered as teaching experience for appointments as Assistant Professor provided the candidates have undergone Residency Programme during the Post Graduate Course period and in the case of candidates who have passed the Post Graduate Course without undergoing residency programme a certificate shall be produced by the candidate from the Principal of the college to the effect that the candidates has got teaching/clinical work experience during the Post Graduate Course period.

Note:(b)

DNB qualifications must be acquired from a Medical College which is recognised by any of the University in Kerala.

Note:(c)

KS&SSR Part-II Rule 10 (a)(ii) is applicable.

In the absence of candidates with the above qualification candidate with

- i. MBBS Degree from a recognised University.
- ii. Permanent Registration under State Medical Council (TCMC) will be considered for the post of Lecturer in the Scale of pay of Rs.15600-39100/- with grade pay Rs.5400/-

NOTE: KS&SSR Part-II Rule 10(a)(ii) is applicable.

Note:(d)

Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.

Note:(e)

In the case of difference in original Caste/Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a Gazette notification in this regard, along with Non creamy layer Certificate/ Community certificate at the time of certificate verification.

8 Mode of submitting Application:-

- (A) Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The photograph uploaded should be one taken after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link Registration Card in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application once submitted is received as provisional and the details cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The applications submitted not in accordance with the conditions stipulated in the notification will be summarily rejected in due course of

processing. Documents to prove qualification, age, Community etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

- (B) If Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calender. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the Mobile phone number registered in it.
- (C) “Candidates who have AADHAR Card should add AADHAR as ID Proof in their profile.”
