Note:- The above vacancies are now in existence. The Ranked List published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancy earmarked to the reservation communities mentioned above but remains unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published on 11.05.2011 (Cat.No.280//2010 Gazette Date:27.10.2010) for the post. This is the third NCA notification for the post owing to the non- availability of qualified candidates belonging to the Muslim and SIUC communities after the first (Cat No. 715/12,Gazette dt. 31.12.2012 and Cat No.260/15, Gazette dt.17.09.2015 respectively) and Second (Cat.No.481/16 dtd. 30.12.2016 and Cat No. 365/16 dt.11.11.2016 respectively) NCA notifications.

Note:-Application of candidates belonging to communities other than those mentioned above will be summarily rejected. Individual rejection memo will not be issued to them.

7. Qualifications

1. Degree in Modern Medicine (MBBS) or equivalent qualification
2. Post Graduate Degree/Diploma in concerned speciality or equivalent qualification.

OR

Diplomate in National Board in concerned speciality.

Note I:-

(1) Preference will be given in direct recruitment to candidates with Post Graduate Degree or Super Speciality Degree over those with Post Graduate Diploma qualifications, other things being equal.

(2) Degree/Post Graduate Diploma/Post Graduate Degree/Super Speciality Degree wherever mentioned in this notification must be either awarded or recognized by any recognized University or equivalent Institution. Medical Post Graduate Degree/Diploma or equivalent qualification recognized by Medical Council of India and Diplomate in National Board awarded by National Board of Examinations only will be considered. Non Medical Degree or Diploma mentioned in this notification must be awarded by any recognized University or equivalent Institution.

(3) Equivalent Medical qualification wherever mentioned in this notification (except DNB) means those qualifications recognized as equivalent by the Medical Council of India.

3. All persons must possess valid registration with Travancore-Cochin Medical Council.

Note:- 1. Rule 10 a (ii) of Part II, KS& SSR is applicable.

2. Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government Order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.

3. In the case of difference in original caste / Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book the candidate shall produce a Gazette notification in this regard, along with NCLC/Community certificate at the time of certificate verification.

4. Appropriate disciplinary action as per Rules of Procedure Rule 22 shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualification regarding education, experience etc. and submit confirmation for writing the examination, irrespective of whether they are present or absent for the examination.

8. Mode of Submitting applications:

(a) Candidates must register as per "ONE TIME REGISTRATION" with the Official website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and Password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for the post. The Photograph uploaded should be taken after 31/12/2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link **Registration Card** in their profile. Candidates are

responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote User-Id for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The applications will be summarily rejected if non compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove Qualification, Experience, community, age etc have to be produced as and when called for.

(b) “If a Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the admission tickets in the last 15 days till the date of test. The application of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation of the availability of admission tickets will be published in the Examination Calender itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone numbers registered in it.

(c) Candidates who have AADHAAR card should add AADHAAR card as ID proof in their profile.
