Applications are invited Online only by “One Time Registration” from qualified candidates belonging to the reservation group of Viswakarma, Scheduled Tribe & SIUC Nadar communities of Kerala State for appointment in the under mentioned post in Kerala Government Service.

- 1. Department** : Kerala Higher Secondary Education
- 2. Name of Post** : Higher Secondary School Teacher (Junior) Arabic
- 3. Scale of Pay** : ₹ 32,300-68,700/-
- 4. Number of vacancies** : Viswakarma - 01 (One) - **Category No. 168/2020**
Scheduled Tribe - 01 (One) - **Category No. 169/2020**
SIUC Nadar - 01 (One) - **Category No. 170/2020**

The above vacancies are now in existence. The Ranked list published as per this notification will be valid until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above communities but remain unfilled due to the paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked list published on 27.08.2019 for the post (Category No.330/2017).

- 5. Method of appointment** : Direct Recruitment (From among candidates belonging to the Viswakarma, Scheduled Tribe, SIUC Nadar Community)

Note: Applications of candidates belonging to communities other than those mentioned will be summarily rejected. Individual communication regarding the rejection of their application will not be issued.

- 6. Age limit** : (1) 20-43 (Candidates belonging to Viswakarma & SIUC Nadar communities) [Only candidates born between 02.01.1977 and 01.01.2000 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.] including para 2(i) of the General conditions.
(2) 20-45 (Candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe communities) [Only candidates born between 02.01.1975 and 01.01.2000 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post.] including para 2(i) of the General conditions.

Note : For other conditions regarding age relaxations, please see Para (2) except para 2(i) of part 2 of the General conditions.

- 7. Qualifications** :
- (1) Master's Degree in the concerned subject with not less than 50% marks awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto in the respective subject by any University in Kerala.
 - (2)
 - (i) B.Ed Degree in the concerned subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any University in Kerala.
 - (ii) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. Degree in the concerned subject, B.Ed Degree acquired in the concerned faculty as specified in the Acts and Statutes of any of the Universities in Kerala.
 - (iii) In the absence of persons with B.Ed. Degree as specified in items (i) and (ii) above, persons with B.Ed. Degree in any subject acquired after a regular course of study from any of the Universities in Kerala or a qualification recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.
 - (3) Must have passed the State Eligibility Test for the post of Higher Secondary School Teacher conducted by Government of Kerala or by the agency authorized by the State Government.

- Note:**
1. Rule 10(a) ii of Part II of KS & SSR is applicable.
 2. In the absence of B.Ed Degree holders, candidates having Masters Degree with not less than 50% marks and who have passed the State Eligibility Test will be considered. Preference will be given to those who have acquired Ph.D/M.Phil. Degree or qualified at Junior Research Fellowship/National Eligibility Test. The teachers appointed under this provision will have to acquire B.Ed Degree at their own expense within five years from the date of entry in service.
 3. Those who have passed Language Teachers Training Course are exempted from acquiring B.Ed. Qualification.
 4. Persons who have acquired M.Ed in the concerned subject recognized by any University in Kerala are exempted from B.Ed qualification.
 5. Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of

qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant Government Order to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification concerned.

6. If the caste of candidates is wrongly mentioned in their SSLC Book, they should claim their original caste in their applications and should produce community certificate issued from concerned revenue authority and the Gazette Notification for the same at the time of certificate verification.

Exemptions:

1. Those persons who have passed the State Level Eligibility Test (SLET) for the post of College Lecturers conducted by Government of Kerala are exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test for Higher Secondary School Teachers.
2. Those persons who have passed the National Eligibility Test/Junior Research Fellowship shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.
3. Persons with Ph.D/M.Phil/M.Ed. degree shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test provided the M.Phil in the concerned subject should be one awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala or recognized as equivalent thereto by any of the Universities in Kerala.
4. The teachers who have completed 10(ten) years of approved teaching service at the High School level in the General Education subordinate service shall be exempted from passing the State Eligibility Test.
5. Relaxation of 5% marks in the Post Graduation will be given to SC/ST and Differently Aabled candidates as per G.O.(Ms) No.288/15/Gl.Edn. Dated 13.11.15.

8. Mode of submitting Application:-

- (A) Candidates must register as per "ONE TIME REGISTRATION" with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the '**Apply Now**' button of the respective post in the Notification Link to apply for the post. The Photograph uploaded should be taken after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link **Registration Card** in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the

personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their profile. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and the details cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The applications if non compliance with the notification is found will be summarily rejected in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, Community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

- (B) If a Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The application of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it.
- (C) Appropriate disciplinary action as per Rules of Procedure Rule 22 shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualification regarding education, experience etc. and submit confirmation for writing the examination, irrespective of whether they are present or absent for the examination.
- (D) “Candidates who have AADHAAR card should add AADHAAR card as I.D. Proof in their profile.”
